- ✓ T&E Card
 - ✓ Corporate-liability card
 - ✓ Airfare, lodging, car rental, ground transportation, and travel meals
 - ✓ Expenses paid directly by University
 - ✓ New application required
 - ✓ Training required
- ✓ Pre-Trip Requests
 - ✓ Required for travel
 - ✓ includes mileage only
 - ✓ includes cash advances
 - ✓ An approved pre-trip request is required before an expense report can be approved.

 - ✓ Manage receipts

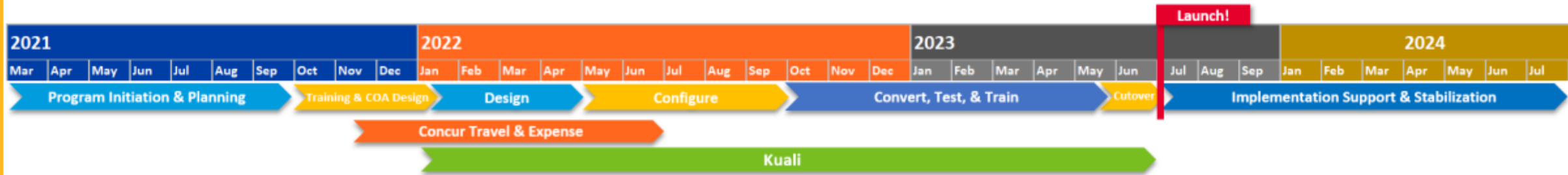
- ✓ Expense Reporting

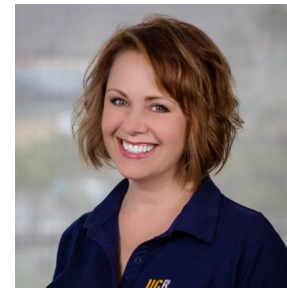

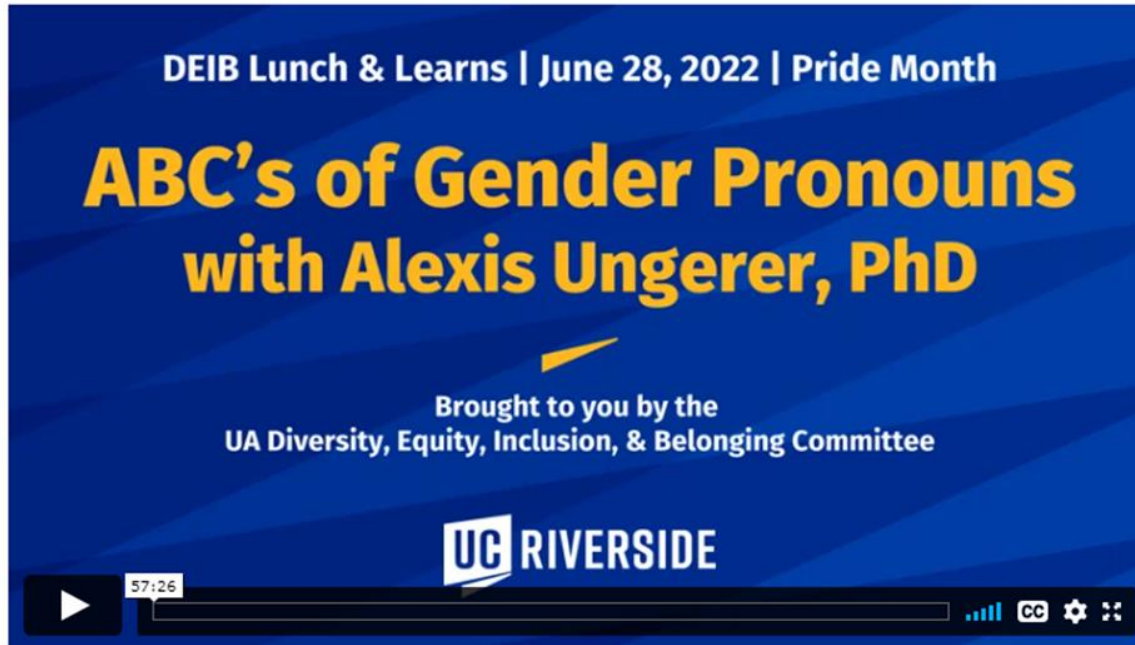
